This allows the children to build up independence skills and allows them to start the morning learning tasks that teachers have set. Many thanks for your support.

Lighthouse 4th October

All children in Year 2-6 are warmly welcomed to Shillingstone Church Centre for Lighthouse on 4^{th} October between $5:30 \, \text{pm} - 7 \, \text{pm}$.

School census 6th October

Each term we are required to complete a census with information relating to the children at school. Our budget for the following financial year is calculated from our Autumn census. As budgets are being squeezed we need to claim all funding available to us.

We get extra funding for any children who are eligible for free school meals. Even if your child receives the universal

free school meal (Reception through to Year 2) we would like parents to apply for the free school meal status. Apart from a free hot meal throughout your child's education the school gets an extra £1320 per child. You will be eligible if you receive

- Income Support
- Employment Support Allowance (Income Related)
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual taxable income (as assessed by The Inland Revenue) which from 6 April 2010 does not exceed £16,190
- Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Please contact Dorset County Council on 01305 221000 and have your National Insurance Number and Date of Birth to hand. You will be told immediately if your child qualifies.
